Reception area	faces are not regularly cleaned down	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pathogerm Ltd using an electro static technology, an anti viral cleaning agent that decontaminates, sanitises and disinfects all surfaces. It is 100% non toxic and is safe to use on all surfaces and equipment. It creates a barrier, protecting against recontamination for up to 4 weeks, we will be respraying the salon every 2 weeks for added protection • Signage displayed in salon for reminders of regular hand washing, technique and coughing/ sneezing into a tissue and disposing • Compulsory hand sanitation upon arrival • Increased frequency of hand washing or hand sanitation • Frequent disinfection of work surfaces • Frequent cleaning of door handles or have internal doors kept open if possible • Paper towels available in bathroom • Reduced amount of traffic • One receptionist to handle phones and technology equipment • Waiting area, social distancing must be observed • Incoming deliveries are to be pre-determined by phone call • A screen is placed between receptionist and client • Access to the phone and technology will be limited to receptionist only • Frequent cleaning of reception. Anyone who has a high temperature will be asked to go home. A high temperature is 37.8 degrees or above • Legionnaires disease water testing to be carried out in both salons • Shower heads will be disinfected prior to opening and every 3 months after • People involved in the assistance to others during an emergency do not have to 1m apart BUT must pay attention to sanitation measures immediately afterwards including washing hands • Anyone (staff member or client) presenting symptoms of a cough, temperature or loss of taste/ smell will be sent home • A suspected cases log will be kept at reception and updated with details if required • Any cases that involve suspected exposure of Coved-19 from the workplace will be reported to RIDDOR 	3	2
